VALDEZ DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM

- 1. Riders ages 16-18 years of age must have this waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian if they are not accompanied by the guardian or parent. A parent or legal guardian must accompany riders under the age of 16.
- 2. Rider, in case of dangerous response, may be asked to leave the vehicle; arrangements will be made to pick up rider as soon as possible.
- 3. Rider must at all times obey the instructions of the officer with whom rider is riding.
- 4. Rider must wear a seatbelt at all times while riding in the vehicle.

I understand that the duties of the Emergency Services may involve a number of dangerous situations and that these situations may be encountered during the period of the Ride-Along.

Therefore, I hereby assume complete and sole responsibility for my personal actions including but not limited to any civil or criminal charges that may arise from my conduct during this program. Also, if I suffer any injury or incur any loss of any kind while participating in the program due to any negligent, accidental, intentional, or willful conduct or action of my own of or any other individual; I will hold harmless, indemnify and defend the City of Valdez and its officers, representatives, employees and agents except to the extent such injury or loss is directly attributable to the City of Valdez.

I understand that if I have any questions regarding this program that those questions will be fully answered prior to my signing this document.

I fully understand this request for participation in the Ride-Along program and have read it thoroughly.

As parent or legal guardian of this minor I take full responsibility for the terms of this agreement.
